

# Moss Curled Parsley

This parsley is a vigorous and high-yielding variety. It has dark green leaves that curl very thickly. These seeds are certified organic, and are an heirloom variety introduced before 1940. This variety is particularly well-suited to the Mid-Atlantic and Southern U.S. regions.

**To use:** Parsley seeds germinate very slowly, requiring 3–4 weeks. Sow seeds in early spring directly into garden. Sowing depth:  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch. Keep seedling area well-watered. To speed up germination process: soak seed in water for 24 hours prior to sowing. Parsley requires full sun. To harvest: snip off the outer, mature stems near base of plant. Leave the central, new growth to continue producing. Avoid removing more than one-third of the plant at any time. To collect seeds, let the plant mature, flower, and turn to seedheads. Cut the dry flowers/seedheads and collect seeds. Store in a cool, dark place until ready for planting.
